... tesla, as we talked about last month, was 100 years ahead of his time, way ahead of his time and very, very frustrating for him to go through this. he understood the transmission of power wirelessly, of energy wirelessly. right now, you have all of these cables strung up all over this planet to transmit energy. he knew back then, and it's actually quite simple. it's amazing that nobody has picked up on it. why? the planet isn't ready. consciousness isn't ready. he was so far ahead of his time. and as I said, he did a very poor job with his public relations. and he had one other big problem. what was that? one other big problem (someone says "money"). money, absolutely. money.

now, he spent so much of his time chasing money. edison sold out early and he had some big, big backers in his work and after a certain point for edison money really wasn't a problem. tesla wanted to do it on his own and really also did not understand business that well. and he just – he was kind of starry-eyed – he just assumed the money was going to be there, and it never was. and he did things that, from a practical business standpoint, were not all that smart. he didn't patent a lot of his work that should have been patented, but he thought it was such an administrative pain in the rear and also expensive.

he had some amazing concepts of airplanes, of robots in about the year 1892, 93. long before anybody ever thought of – and not airplanes with propellers, but with turbines. he really understood the forces of turbines. he had a money problem that really prevented him from doing the experiments that he would have really

liked to have done. he could have done hundreds of more times the amount of work that he did. and he's truly – we should give him credit for being the one who brought the power of electricity to each and every one of you through ac (alternating current), in particular, and he simply hasn't been given enough credit for it. but he a money problem and the money problem really kept him from doing the work he wanted to do. (adamus pauses, giving the audience the stink eye; some chuckles)

does that sound a little bit familiar to any of you? sart: what do you mean?

adamus: "what do you mean?" yeah, yeah (more chuckles). he was ahead of his time like all of you are. as I said last month, you're the teslas of consciousness. he had a money problem that kept him from really doing his work.

now, it's debated on the other realms, if he'd had the money, how would that have changed the planet? was the planet ready for, first of all, the transmission of wireless energy? that means none of your electric cables and cords and all the rest of that. all wireless. was the planet ready at that point for basically travel, not in automobiles, but true electromagnetic machines? he understood that. and it's coming sooner or later to this planet, nonpolluting, non-energy guzzling electromagnetic transportation machines. he understood it, at least through his visions. he understood how to do it. he just didn't have the money to set it up for the experiments.

he also understood a very simple thing, and we wonder was the planet ready for it or not? he

understood that energy is free and it's available everywhere. everywhere to everyone. it's kind of a nobrainer, but yet nobody has been able to hit on it yet. is the planet ready for it? is the planet ready for wireless transmission of energy, free and abundant and nonpolluting energy? is the planet ready for electromagnetic vehicles that go so fast and nonpolluting, non-energy – they don't use much energy at all. is the planet ready for that? it makes you wonder. anybody, do you think the planet is ready for that? (some say "yes," someone says "it'll be fun too") yeah, yeah.

and I don't want to say there's a right or a wrong answer to that. it's subject to a lot of discussion and a lot of debate. some on the planet are ready, like you and like so many – well, all of the rest of you. you are ready for that, but given this free energy, wireless energy, one person who's taking antidepression medications, just one person who goes a little nuts – it's the same argument with guns and everything else; well, theoretically, you know, everybody can have a gun for target practice, but all it takes is one – and that's the dilemma we're in on this planet right now. it's there. tesla knew it. he was a hundred years ahead of his time.

'so, what's happening now between tesla and musk? they come from different I AMS, different souls. they're not reincarnations of each other at all. tesla hasn't reincarnated since he left in 1943 at age 86. died basically poor and alone. and I bring this up because I see so many analogies, relationships between you and tesla, up to a point. I see that he was a brilliant

visionary. he knew. he had a knowingness within him. he had these visions all the time. it wasn't even his mind that was going all the time. it was this con- ... he was tuned into a stream of consciousness that was always there. he learned at a very early age not to put it down.

(pause as adamus gives the stink eye across the audience again)

to allow it. now, it drove him a little crazy at points, because it was always flowing through. he had a problem sticking with one project to the other, because there were a hundred projects coming through his creative source.

he died at age 86 and his human self felt that it hadn't done a good job. he was actually rather bitter. he had tremendous respect for thomas edison. they worked together for a time. but he also had been taken advantage of by edison and he felt that edison was, again, not a true visionary, but rather just an inventor, kind of like just an engineer. edison did amazing things, but he didn't have the vision that dear tesla had.

so tesla, when he crossed over right in the midst of world war II, he knew that he could have developed certain weapons that would have brought a much faster end to the war. he wasn't listened to by the department of war. he had come up with things that really just would – so simple, using energy – he really understood energy – that could have scared the hell out of any enemy on the planet. well, he crossed over right in the midst of the war and he knew at that point that he was far ahead of his time and that it really –

this sounds a little strange – but it wasn't meant to work out. I mean, it could have, but he said he was just too far ahead of his time. the planet really wasn't ready. but he said, "when the planet is ready for it, I'm going to find the right person to channel me, to connect with me."

so now let's go to elon musk. born in africa. had a lot of hardships when he was growing up, I mean, nothing undue, but it wasn't an easy life. he started talking to entities when he was about three years old, I mean consciously talking to entities.

(pause for another stink eye to the audience; laughter) but he didn't block it out. he rather enjoyed it. you know, it was kind of like a friend for him. he allowed it. and when he told others about it and they said he was crazy, he did it anyway, because he really enjoyed these talks with the entities.

he had a very good quick mind, but again, elon musk is not the most intelligent. I mean he's got what you would call a high iq, but he was open and he also, like tesla, was a visionary. he came into this lifetime saying, "I want to do something. I want to make a difference on this planet."

when he was just six, seven years old, he was talking about making a machine that would take him and others to mars. he followed these dreams. he didn't put them down (another stink eye to the audience), and when others told him he was crazy, he didn't see it that way. he kind of knew that he was ahead of his time, in a way.

he wasn't going to let abundance issues stop him. he wasn't going to let that old core issue of unworthiness

stop him. he knew it was going to take a lot of money to travel to mars - I mean it's not just a \$1.75 to get there - so he allowed abundance into his life to realize his dreams (another stink eye and a few chuckles). he took huge risks along the way, because he would have much rather tried and failed than to have never tried at all (more stink eye and more chuckles). so along the way he kept these talks going. he didn't know who he was talking to. he didn't think it was some angelic entity. he just thought it was part of his mental process - talking to these beings. but at a relatively early age, dear tesla kind of felt into him and said, "this is the right one. this is the right one. he's open. he listens. he has vision. he's not just a pragmatist. he really has vision and he's never going to let doubt get in his way" (more stink eye and some giggles). so, tesla connected with elon musk and has been connected ever since, talking to him on a regular basis.

now, elon musk would never say ... hello, elon, by the way (some chuckles). I kind of figured you might be listening. but elon would never say, "well, no, I'm not channeling anything," and to which I would reply, "so, elon you know that there is something called inspiration that comes along. you know that you hit these moments and everything kind of comes together and you're in this flow and you can see where others cannot. and you go beyond your doubts, you go beyond just the humanness and you just allow yourself to be in that bigger place. and you can feel it in your body and you can feel it just in how the mind is resonating, but you also know there's something

more. and you have these times, a lot of times of this. and maybe there aren't words spoken, and maybe one doesn't come along and say, 'I am nikola tesla,' but tesla's working with you. why do you think you named a couple of your companies tesla, when in fact you have gone on record of saying, you actually had more respect for thomas edison and edison's inventions, but here you are, naming companies tesla." so, tesla is working with you and it may not be right now about free energy, but perhaps ultimately, but it is

now about free energy, but perhaps ultimately. but it is about a grander vision for this planet, a grander way of doing things, and good lord knows that elon musk has took huge challenges, put everything on the table (another stink eye to shaumbra), not holding anything back, willing to take the risk and not overanalyzing it. that's one thing I do love about elon's energy, he doesn't overanalyze. he gets to a point where he connects with what we call his knowingness, but he feels it, he sees it, in a manner of speaking, and he knows it, and then he follows it.

and he's come close to the edge a number of times in terms of business success and failure, but also finds that a little bit exhilarating (more stink eye and a few chuckles). and here he is connecting with tesla and I see the relationship going on for a while. for me it's exciting, because my connection with tesla, in particular, is through mark twain. tesla and twain were great friends, dear friends and it deeply, deeply saddened tesla when mark twain died, because it was one of tesla's last true friends. they spent a lot of time in the laboratory, but again, that connecting energy between them – they were both visionaries. they were

both wide open. they were both a little bit ahead of their time, tesla a lot more so than mark twain. but they both had the ability to see and feel and open up into grander spaces. they got out of their chicken little, chicken crap way of being a little human. they broke out of boxes and really lived. they followed their passion.

they had doubts, like you, a lot of doubts. poor tesla was eventually so ridiculed by the press and by the academia and musk has been attacked by many, but they go beyond those doubts because doubts are so petty. doubts are petty. your doubts are so petty, but yet they get so big, they kind of mushroom out and they cover everything else up. tesla and musk had doubts. musk still has doubts, but he takes a breath and goes beyond that and follows his visions and his passions.

so that's the connection between them, between us and tesla and musk. I see that continuing for quite a while and great things coming from elon musk and those who work with him and those who energetically support what tesla and musk are doing. so that's the connection, my dear friends, yes. and there should be so many reminders to you about your lives. you didn't come here for just another life. you didn't come here to be covered up with doubts. you didn't come here to be whiny. you learned how to, but you didn't come here for that (some chuckles). you didn't come here to be victims. you came here with a vision, something much grander – matter of fact, probably too grand. I mean, the vision of what we're doing probably maybe a little too grand, but let's spit on that and just

can you imagine what it was like for nikola tesla, for instance, having these great visions and then having everybody tell him he's crazy, he's just a dreamer, he doesn't know what he's talking about? it's taken over 100 years – or less, 75 years – for a little bit of vindication with that. but can you imagine what he went through? he saw it, he knew it, but then everybody said he's crazy and he kind of started to believe that. but yet he still had that passion inside.

now, okay, bear with me for a moment here. so, we've got tesla working with musk. we've got mark twain, friend of tesla, and they're still communicating in a lot of different ways.

we've got tesla now, who is taking an interest in the crimson circle, not just because I'm talking about him, because he's fascinated – he's an energy innovator, and he's fascinated by this whole new twist of energy innovation that's happening. it never dawned on him that actually you could change your personal relationship to energy. never occurred to him. so, we have tesla now taking an interest. he and I have had some good talks. he's taken an interest in crimson circle not because of your airy-fairy spiritual stuff, which he still doesn't go for. but he's going, "all right, here's some who really are getting into deep physics, real physics of energy," a subject that's always fascinated him. so, he's taking more of an interest and he's working now with another being to

help with basically you'd call it a communication software - it's not really software software, it's just a communication patterning - that's going to help really release that mass consciousness. it's a frequency. now, the one he's working with - this should be no surprise to you - but our dear john kuderka, absolutely (audience sheers and applauds). absolutely, so they're ... you should see those two. oh (some chuckles). they're working on how do you develop - I'm going to have to call it a frequency, they don't really like that word - but how do you develop this communication? and I've said before energy is just communication. that's all it is. how to develop a refined communication that helps one really release mass consciousness? and from this initial work in releasing mass consciousness, it can possibly be expanded to other things like old hypnotic programming and things like that. but that's what nikola and john are working on, and they have kind of what I would call their laboratory. I mean, it doesn't have - well, actually it does have some physical instruments, kind of physical. that's what they're spending their days and nights on. I don't know when they're going to be ready to discuss it, but I will keep you posted (someone says "wow"). yes, yes (someone shouts "woo!" and more applause).'
